Part Three

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The Exiled Zadok Priesthood's Understanding of the Position Of The Feast Of First Fruits

From the ancient Zadok priesthood writings (Qumran Library) who were forcefully exiled from the Temple around 60 BCE, under violent persecution by *the Pharisee Rabbinics when they took control over the Temple*, we now understand that a different Judaism pre-existed contemporary Rabbinical Judaism that followed a solar based religious calendar, and that they testified strongly against the Pharisee/Rabbinic imposition of a lunar based calendar over the Temple worship which occurred from approximately 60-70 years immediately preceding the birth of Yahushua Messiah.

From the Zadok testimony we find a Judaism that follows a calendar similar to that declared by ancient Enoch. According to the "Sons of Zadok" testimony,

- 1. The biblical calendar was solar based determined by the annual "circuit" of the sun (i.e. the time taken in the earths' annual orbit of the sun.
- 2. The 1st day of the year was identified by the observation of the day of the vernal equinox.
- 3. The Weekly Sabbath was identified by counting the identified 1st day of the year as the fourth day of the week.
- 4. The Feast Of First Fruits was positioned as occurring after the first Weekly Sabbath that occurred <u>after</u> the full completion of the period of 7 days of Unleavened Bread.

This Zadok calendar can be seen falling out as follows:

The identification of the day of the Feast of First Fruits then enabled the 50 day count (with 7 Weekly Sabbaths) to identity the Feast of Weeks

Yahushua Messiah's Behaviour In Regard To The Position Of The Feast Of First Fruits And The Feast Of Weeks

However the Apostolic testimony is that Yahushua Messiah observed the Law of Moses without *sin or iniquity* under the Law of Moses. Thus it is confirmed that Yahushua must have observed biblical calendar that was 100% correct under the law of Moses and according to YHVH's commandments.

The Apostolic testimony (Mark 14:12-28; Luke 22:1-20) gives careful note of the timing and description of Yahushua observing His last Passover meal with His disciples, as taking place on the full day prior to the Pharisee/Rabbinic calendar timing of their Passover meal, which they had imposed on the temple. (For more exhaustive discussion on this difference between the timing of Yahushua's Passover and the Pharisee/Rabbinic temple calendar of Passover, please see: What Calendar Did Yahushua Keep – Whose Report Will We Believe? (Sept 2012).

From the Apostolic testimony of Yahushua's last Passover, we learn that:

- It occurred a full day before the Rabbinic Passover/ Unleavened Bread meal according to the Apostles account, and on the Pharisee/ Rabbinic calendar governing the temple practices at that time, the day of the Passover preparation occurred on the next day, when Yahushua was crucified.
- Two disciples were sent to find a man carrying a water pitcher, whom we now know was a Zadok priest following the solar biblical calendar
- They would follow that man to the Zadok quarters for Yahushua's Passover, as it had been ceremonial cleansed according to the required timing and would be ready for Yahushua's Passover.
- Yahushua called this man 'the good man"
- That the disciples must tell him that Yahushua would keep His Passover/Unleavened Bread (not a last supper) that night in the man's guest upper room
- That neither the Apostles nor the "Goodman" showed any protest that this request was an
 incorrect day for the Passover meal to be held, or that this was unlawful according to the law
 of Moses, or that they should rather only be doing this the following day, as was the
 Pharisee/Rabbinic religious practices in control of the Temple at that time.
- By their testimony the Apostles clearly demonstrate that the Pharisees Day of Preparation for the Passover Feast occurred the very next day after Yahushua's remembrance of His Passover Feast (Day 14 of the Zadok solar calendar).
- Thus on the Rabbinic calendar their "Nisan 14" was in fact day 15 on Yahushua's / Zadok solar calendar.

So to this point of the identification of the Passover meal and the seven days of Unleavened bread we find Yahushua in harmony with the Zadok solar calendar, but not in harmony with the Pharisee/Rabbinic lunar calendar

However, when we follow Yahushua to find the timing of the Feast of First Fruits, we find the Apostolic testimony of Yahushua is that He was raised from the dead in accord with His prophecy of Jonah – there would be 3 days and 3 nights that Yahushua would be in the grave, until His resurrection from the dead.

Matthew 12:

- 38 ¶ Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.
- 39 But he answered and said unto them, An evil and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given to it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas:
- 40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
- 41 The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas is here.

Yahushua Our FirstFruits

The Apostolic testimony is that, in accord with His prophecy of the "sign of Jonah", Yahushua indeed was raised from the dead after 3 days and 3 nights, and that in the resurrection of Yahushua from the dead, Yahushua was the "first fruits" of all YHVH's people who would be raised from the dead, whether they be currently asleep or yet to be transformed in the last day.

1 Cor 15:

- 16 For if the dead rise not, then is not Messiah raised:
- 17 And if Messiah be not raised, your faith is vain; ye are yet in your sins.
- 18 Then they also which are fallen asleep in Messiah are perished.
- 19 If in this life only we have hope in Messiah, we are of all men most miserable.
- 20 ¶ But now is Messiah risen from the dead, and become the firstfruits of them that slept.
- 21 For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.
- 22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Messiah shall all be made alive.
- 23 But every man in his own order: <u>Messiah the firstfruits</u>; afterward they that are Messiah's at his coming.
- 24 Then cometh the end, when he shall have delivered up the kingdom to the Almighty, even the Father; when he shall have put down all rule and all authority and power.
- 25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet.
- 26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.
- 27 For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under him, it is manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.
- 28 And when all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that The Almighty may be all in all.

From this testimony we learn that:

- Yahushua is the first fruits offering of men unto YHVH
- Yahushua was the first to be raised from the dead of all men who have died / will die in faith of YHVH or are yet to be transformed the end of the age.

In the law of Moses, YHVH's people were to observe the feast of First fruits and bring the First fruits of their labour as an offering before YHVH (Exodus 23:16). The Feast of First Fruits marked the ingathering of the Barley, whereas the Feast of Weeks would mark the first fruits offering of the ingathering of the wheat. Likewise the Apostolic testimony of Yahushua's resurrection is that He is our First Fruits offering, where Yahushua *is the first fruits of YHVH's great harvest of men*.

Only one – Yahushua was able to make the offering of First Fruits as the perfect last man (the last Adam, 1 Cor 15:45) who was without sin, whereas the Feast of Weeks marks the offering of the first fruits of men who are truly born of the Spirit of YHVH above through their faith in, and love for Yahushua the Good Shepherd, the Lamb of YHVH.

Thus, looking at Yahushua's resurrection and offering of First Fruits unto YHVH, and in accord with the "Sign of Jonah" (the 3 days and nights in the grace until the resurrection) we find that Yahushua demonstrates the appointed time of the feast of First Fruits (the day of His resurrection) on a day that is earlier then the Zadok understanding, since the count to Yahushua's First Fruits begins on the day following the weekly Shabbat that occurs within the 7 day Feast of Unleavened Bread.

Thus, in the context of the calendar timing of the events surrounding the crucifixion and resurrection, we see that Yahushua's demonstration of the Feast of First Fruits (the day of the Resurrection) occurs on the 19th day of the year, whereas the Zadok's held it to be on the 26th day of the year, a full 7 days after the 7 days after Yahushua's resurrection and His demonstration of YHVH's Appointed Time of First Fruits.

This can be seen as follows:

Plausible Reason As To Why Yahushua's Demonstration Of First Fruits Differs From The Zadok Calendar

We see in the diagram how Yahushua's behaviour demonstrates consistency with the Zadok calendar for Passover and Unleavened bread, but differs from First Fruits. We know that:

- 1. Yahushua is the Word of YHVH, and it was by Yahushua that creation was made in the beginning (see John 1:1-19), Thus Yahushua would be intimate with the Divine appointed times
- 2. Yahushua was not guilty of any sin (1 John 3:5) under the Law of Moses, and thus the calendar he demonstrates must be absolutely correct according to YHVH's Law

Why then would the Zadok's have a difference in their identification of First Fruits?

The only answer that might give reasonable cause is that when the Babylonian captivity was ended, and the faithful remnant returned, in the book of Nehemiah we read that they had forgotten the law of Moses. It was Ezra the priest who returned and taught all the remnant the law of Moses (See Nehemiah chapter 8).

Nehemiah 9 records the remnant's awakening and confessing their sins to YHVH and that historically all Israel had turned away from YHVH's law and forgotten it. But YHVH was merciful and restored their understanding to the point that the temple and the priests could once again function.

Nehemiah 9:34

Neither have our kings, our princes, our priests, nor our fathers, kept thy law, nor hearkened unto thy commandments and thy testimonies, wherewith thou didst testify against them.

The testimony that the priests did not keep (had forgotten) YHVH's law is evidence that centuries of mixed religious practices had significant affect on the *religious memory of Israel*. This is also described by the Zadok's priesthood as what occurred in the century that preceded the coming of Yahushua. The Zadok's clung to the instructions of Enoch for the calendar for it was astronomically

correct in many respects, however the need to intercalate an extra 7 days every 5th or 6th year, because of their use of the counting of days of the month according to Enoch, indicates that the Zadok did not have everything correct. Even they testified that they were looking for the prophesied "Teacher Of Righteousness" to come and "restore all things". This testimony in itself reveals that they acknowledged that they did not have all the understanding of YHVH's ways restored to them at that time.

Ultimately as recorded in Acts 6:7 a great multitude of the priests came to faith in accord with the Apostolic testimony – these were exiled remnant of the Zadok and Levite priesthood that had been driven out of the temple by the Pharisee Rabbinics some 80-90 years earlier. In coming into obedient faith of Yahushua as the "Teacher of Righteousness" and acknowledging Yahushua as Messiah, they would have recognised Yahushua as being the "First Fruits" resurrected begotten *Son of YHVH*, in accordance with the Apostolic testimony, and they would have realised the day of His resurrection as a *correction* to their calendar with respect to the Feast of First Fruits, along with its associated lawful count of days to the identification of the Feast of Weeks.

Interestingly, now with the revelation for the Qumran scrolls, the writings and testimony of the exiled Zadok priesthood, we find ancient historical proof that reveals that Rabbinical Judaism, since the times of Yahushua has worked hard to completely obliterate the religious memory of the House of Judah as remembered by the Zadok priesthood. Just as historical Christendom bound up Israel in a religious prison house, so to has been the motivation of Pharisee Rabbinicalism to the House of Judah. So it is that both houses Of Israel have been bound in the prison houses of apostate religion and once again we wait for the "breaker" – who is Yahushua Messiah – who will come and restore all things (Mat 17:10).

Following Yahushua's Footsteps To Find The Feast Of Weeks

From the day of the resurrection of Yahushua messiah, we are then able to identify the Feast of Weeks (Shavuot) according to the instructions of Leviticus 23. When associated with the Gregorian calendar, given the *true sun observation* at the equinox on the 21st March, we find that the Feast of Weeks occurs on Tuesday 27th May 2014
