Biblical High Days & Weekly Sabbaths And Apostolic Testimony of Yahushua's Sign Of Jonah

Note: Gregorian calendar dates and days change each successive year, but Biblical calendar day counts do not change.

Zaddok calendar precept: The occurrence of the equinox is day 1 of the new year but day 4 of the biblical week according to the law of the creation of the luminaries on the 4th day of the week - Gen 1:14-19

Expected Observed Sun Dial Vernal Equinox dates for 2020, Jerusalem meridian time (i.e. not "mean sun" equinox calculation times as presented on our typical calendars) , Autumnal = 23rd Sept 2020 (Mean sun average (calculation) = 22nd Sep 2021, 10:20 pm

Note: True sun observation vs Mean sun estimates: What is The Difference?

It is important to know the difference, especially if you have been unable to identify the sun dial observation due to cloudy conditions!

All listings of the occurrence of the equinox on typical published calendars is a mathematical estimate - known as the "mean sun estimate" - an average estimation from a standardised mathematical formula.

When our common published (Jerusalem time) calendar presentation of the "mean sun estimation" of the equinox is presented as occurring (Jerusalem Longitude) in the evening after dusk, then our research is that the actual true sun observation of the equinox as practically observed on a sun dial (the tell tale straight line) would occur on the very next day when the sun is shining .

With this understanding one can still identify when the actual day of the true observed sun occurrence of the equinox would occur from what is mathematically estimated (for Jerusalem) as presented on our common calendars.

Expected True Observed Sun Autumnal Equinox Jerusalem Meridian - on 23rd Sept 2021. (Mean sun estimate of Jerusalem Equinox 22 Sept at 10:20 pm, Jerusalem IST)

Recent Dead Sea Scroll Fragment Translation Reveals The Position Of The Feast Of First Fruits - confirms Lev 23:15

"These dates constituted an extension of the festival of Shavuot as we know it today, which celebrates the New Wheat," the researchers said. "According to this calendar, the festival of New Wheat falls 50 days after the first Sabbath following Passover..."

The article doesn't specifically mention the Feast of First Fruits, but states that this last Dead Sea Scrolls fragment recently translated (2018) describe the festival of "New Wheat" as counted 50 days after the first weekly Sabbath following Passover, - that means the Feast of First Fruits is thereby identified because that is day 1 of the 50 day count - the 1st day after the weekly sabbath that immediately follows the PASSOVER (i.e. not after the full 7 days of Unleavened Bread are complete) - so the fragment is pointing to the Feast of First Fruits as occurring on the next day immediately after the first weekly sabbath following Passover.
